## This week we have learned:

We have been focusing on counting in steps of 2,5 and 10 this week, by singing songs and playing lots of games. We have been carrying on with doubling and have used base 10 to help us double numbers. We have written our own riddles this week and I must say they are super! We enjoyed reading each others riddles and guessing the answer. In topic we have been learning about the different parts of a plant and what job the part has. We have also looked at what a plant needs to survive and learnt a song to remember the key words. Our seeds have started to grow and small shoots can be seen. In RE we have been looking at parables and Bible stories which teach us about forgiveness. In phonics we have been looking at the alternative spellings for 'n'- 'kn and gn'.



## Next week we will be learning:

During Maths we will be looking at division, we will begin by halving numbers and move on to dividing by grouping and sharing. We will use objects to practically share and move on to devise our own pictorial representations. In English we are going to be looking at present and past tense and when we use each tense. We will also look at persuasive language and sentences and see if we can persuade people to go to different places. We will look at features of persuasive leaflets and magpie some of their ideas. During topic we are going to be interviewing Mrs Hodgson and asking her all things gardening! We are then going to be conducting an experiment on the best conditions for a plant to grow.
