## **This week:**

It was lovely to see many of you at our Wonderful Wednesday, the children all enjoyed challenging parents to complete the times tables grid.

In English we have brought together all of our learning during this half term, to innovate our own versions of 'Leon and the Place Between'. The children have done a fabulous job writing their own stories.

The focus of our maths lessons this week has been angles and statistics. The children went on a hunt around the classroom to find angles, describing them as acute, obtuse or right angles. They have also looked at interpreting data from scaled bar charts.

During our science lesson we recapped sound waves and how these change when the volume or pitch of the sound changes. We then applied this knowledge when making our own musical instrument that could play a variety of pitches. With Mrs. Aisbitt and Mrs Smith, the children have started to sew and decorate their passport covers, they are looking fantastic.

## **Next week:**

In English we will be looking at poems, comparing different forms of poetry, identifying the features to apply to our own writing

Maths we will continue to look at statistics, we will also be completing a variety of maths contextual problems.
